AWARD

[1] The parties appeared before me for the monthly grievance arbitration hearing. The following matters were adjourned to our next monthly hearing to be held December 10, 2020, on the following terms:

[2] This termination grievance is related to criminal charges. Hydro One seeks documents from the Crown brief. I have directed the PWU to provide Hydro One with the information of the Crown who has carriage of the criminal matter. Hydro One will draft a summons for the Crown to produce the Crown brief at the December 10, 2020 hearing. The Grievor shall provide consent to the disclosure.

HO-T- 4039

[3] This grievance concerns a claim for long-term disability (LTD) benefits. The parties shall provide the third-party administrator, Morneau Shapell, with all the medical records related to the claim, including the WSIB file. The Grievor shall provide any necessary consents required to provide Morneau Shapell with the medical records. The matter will be brought back on before me on December 10, 2020.
